

FNI Clutch Covers

- 1. Remove stock Clutch Cover.
- 2. Make sure the clutch is clean and threads are clean and free of threadlock. Make sure clutch shaft if free of retaining compound and is smooth and clean.
- 3. Install FNI Cluch Cover.
- 4. Torque clutch cover bolts, using a calibrated torque wrench, to <u>95 in-lbs</u>. (If your torque wrench goes over 200 in-lbs it is too big and should not be used for this application.)
